Disability Services in College

If you are going to college and you have an IEP or 504 plan you are eligible for accommodations!

To receive accommodations at the college level you must register with your college's <u>Office of Disability Services</u>. You need to provide the office with documentation to determine what accommodations they can provide to you.

Some examples of accommodations you may receive in college are: extra time on tests, preferential seating, a scribe for taking notes, and more depending on the extent of your disability/ impairment.

It is your responsibility to reach out to Disability Services at your college if you would like to continue receiving accommodations!

Applications submitted in December/January will allow for placement testing and early registration

<u>If you are applying to a 4</u> <u>Year School</u> be aware of your deadlines
